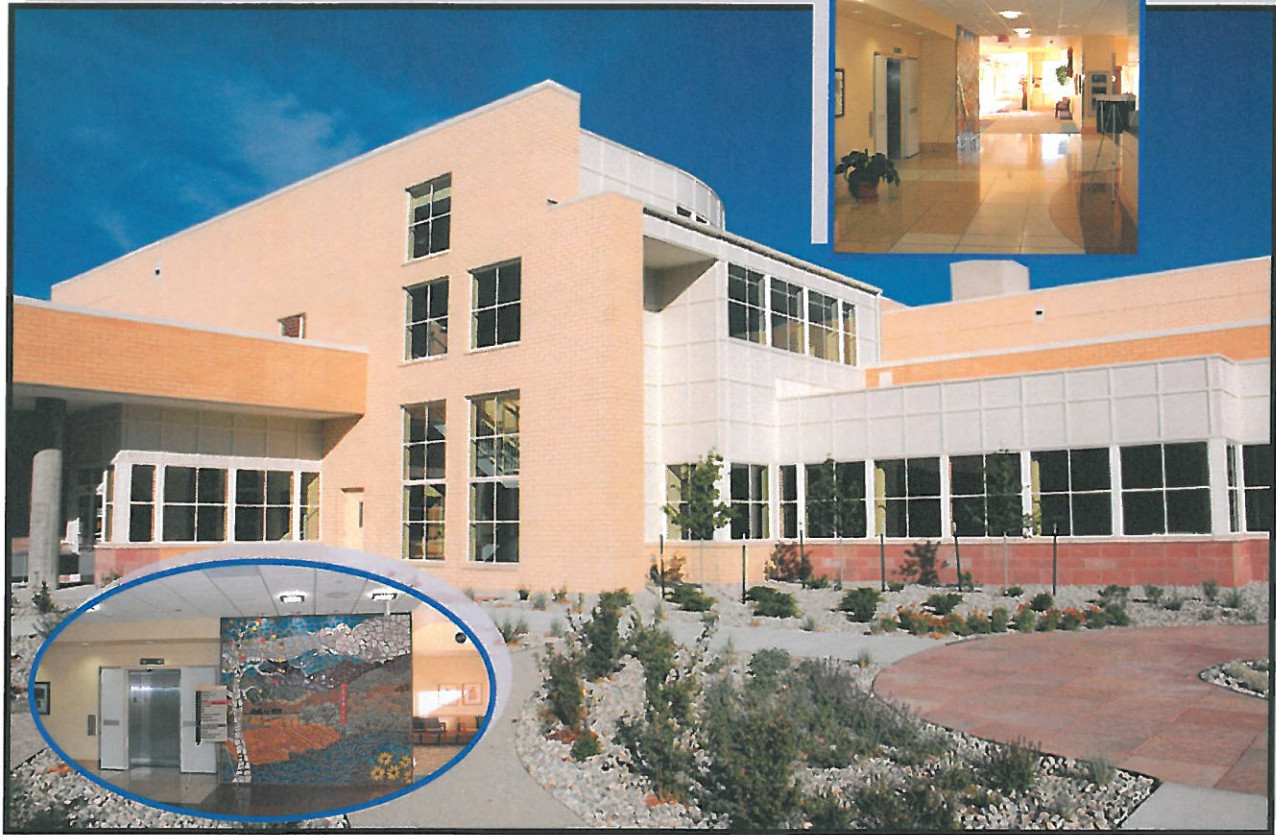

Ft. replacement hospital is a new, more efficient facility that attracts more physicians, medical staff and technicians to the area, maximizing the hospital's capabilities while maintaining staffing levels and minimizing operational costs. The new medical facility also provides for energy savings by incorporating green building systems such as PVC free wall protection and lumber from certified forests. This facility was specifically designed to be a state of the art critical access hospital. The inpatient rooms are all private single rooms on the second floor and have spectacular mountain views.
